New GI 360° broadcast, 17 March 2022

The quarterly GI 360° broadcasts, produced by the Global Industrie exhibition, provide useful content for companies seeking information and insight on the world of industry. Following programs on reshoring, 5G, circular industry, hydrogen and skills, this new edition of GI 360° will discuss artificial intelligence, one of the key links of the industry of the future. It will be placed online on the 17th of March 2022, on the Global Industrie website.

In 2021¹, the French artificial intelligence sector had 81 laboratories (the largest number in any European country) and nearly 13,500² employees working in more than 500 Al start-ups. Having entered the second phase of the national strategy launched in 2018, artificial intelligence benefits from a budget of 2.22 billion Euros.

Targets for 2025: supporting and accelerating the modernization of 500 SMEs and mid-caps through the adoption and use of AI, training 3,700 students and reaching a 15 % share of the world market, and making France an international leader in this field.

The one-hour broadcast will begin with an economic overview of the industrial sector, followed by a debate on the theme of the day, and will end with a virtual tour of a factory of the future, a source of inspiration for new investment projects.
